Subject: Students & Young professionals - ideas for ICoTA Exhibition & Conference 2024

Lucas,

Sorry it took me so long to follow up on the discussion we had a while ago..

Here are some ideas on how to engage & attract young professionals (YP) to our main ICoTA event next year, and to help the Industry attract the best talents:

- 1. Career Pathways Fair type of setting (representatives from different service lines: CT, WL, SL, tools, equipment OEM, Coiled Tubing OEM, Service companies, Operators) with the goal to help the YPs understand different career paths, roles, product lines, and to establish direct contacts.
- Career Mentors Fair (meet & greet those from the Industry who have volunteered to be the personal guides / mentors or even coaches). Ideally, these mentors should be the ones volunteering for the Career Pathways Fair. Note that would require some commitment from the ICoTA folks. I think, we should have a reward program for ICoTA mentors / coaches going forward.
- 3. Hiring / Internship Fair (supported by HR recruiters) attached to the Career Pathways Fair.
- 4. ePoster or podium presentations of intervention related projects (no paper required). The presenters should receive ICoTA certificates they could use to support their resumes.
- 5. Resume review / writing workshop.
- 6. Basic Well Intervention Technologies training (primers) 1-2 hours each. The attendees should also get some sort of certificates for their resumes.

These are just high-level overviews that may require specifics. Please, let me know if/how/when you wish to discuss these.
